AWARD DESCRIPTIONS

ALEX FEE MEMORIAL AWARD - YOUNG LAWYERS SECTION

is given to a member of the YLS who is making a significant pro bono contribution either directly or through a pro bono organization.

LEE A. CAPLAN AWARD

is geared toward a solo or small firm practitioner who has rendered pro bono service over many years.

JUDGE ROBERT M. BELL AWARD

is presented to an individual who has distinguished her/himself as an exemplar of pro bono service, going above and beyond the average pro bono commitment for at least 5 years.

DISTINGUISHED PRO BONO VOLUNTEER AWARD

is presented to an individual who has distinguished her/himself as an exemplar of pro bono service, going above and beyond the average pro bono commitment either over a period time or through extended service in a complex matter or case.

RETIRED PRO BONO VOLUNTEER AWARD

is presented to an individual who is making a significant pro bono contribution while retired.

MEMBER OF THE JUDICIARY AWARD

is presented to a judge who has contributed to the overall pro bono effort by encouraging participation among attorneys, or increasing access to the judicial system for legal services for low-income clients.

GOVERNMENT OR CORPORATE LEGAL DEPARTMENT

is presented to a public agency or private corporate department which incorporates pro bono legal services to the poor into its general practice.

HERBERT S. GARTEN SPECIAL PROJECT AWARD

is presented to an individual, group, firm, or ad hoc group that has initiated a special project that enhances the delivery of legal services for low-income persons.

NON-LEGAL OR ORGANIZATIONAL INVOLVEMENT AWARD

recognizes organizations providing non-legal services which have made a substantial contribution toward the delivery of pro bono legal services to low-income clients.

LAW FIRM PRO BONO SERVICE AWARD

recognizes innovative approaches to the delivery of free legal services and the encouragement of participation by the greatest number of attorneys relative to that firm's size.
